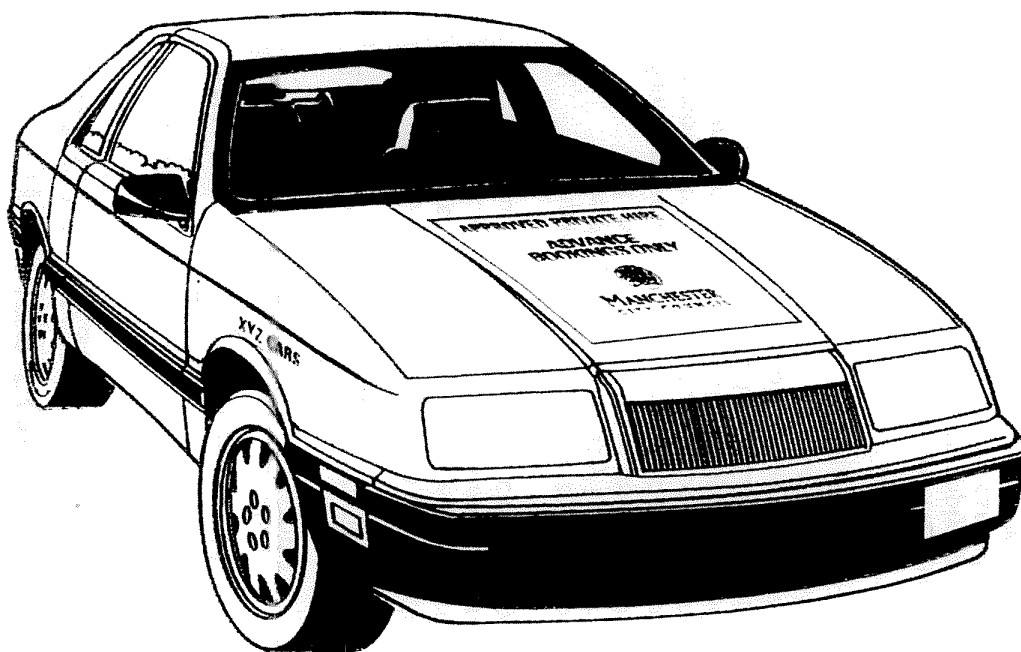

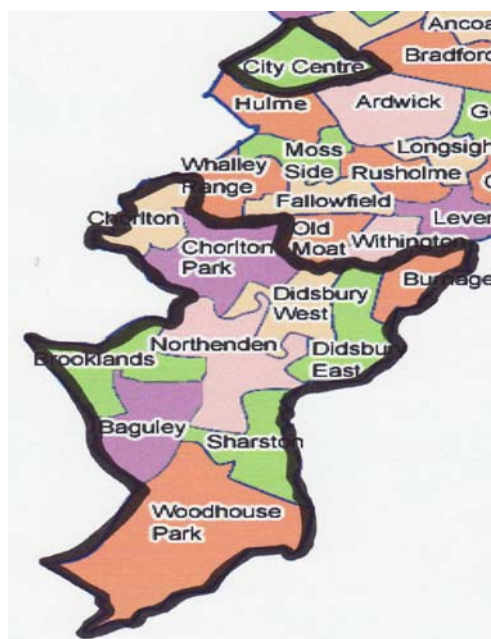

## Reading and Understanding the Greater Manchester Street A-Z Atlas

### **Everyone thinks they can use an A-Z correctly.... not all applicants get it right!**

An A-Z is a very useful tool when used correctly:

- It helps with routes from one location to another giving all road names along the way.
- It lists street names, towns and places in alphabetical order (districts are written in *italics* next to the street name).
- It also lists landmarks such as larger public buildings, hospitals, churches and sports grounds by their name.

#### **Objective 1: Finding locations in the A-Z**

##### **Open your A-Z and find Pink Bank Lane, *Longsight***

Note down the page number and reference.

If you have used the A-Z correctly, you will be confident that you have the correct Pink Bank Lane and not a Pink Bank Lane in a different area. You should also be able to do this without knowing where *Longsight* is located.

If you are not certain, there is an easy method to find the location you are looking for using the A-Z.

**Step 1:** First, look up the area, NOT the street (areas are listed in A-Z in blue text):  
*i.e. Longsight*

**Step 2:** Write down the page number only for the area:  
*i.e. page 95*

**Step 3:** Now find the street you are looking for with the same page number as you noted down in Step 2:  
*i.e. Pink Bank Lane, page 95*

**Step 4:** Write down the grid reference number for the street with the correct page number:  
*i.e. Pink Bank Lane, 5M 95*

**Step 5:** Check your answer is correct.

## Objective 2: Finding “St” locations

**Please find: St John’s Road (*Heaton Mersey*) (answer on page 21)**

Many people look for these types of locations by looking under ‘St’ in the index or under ‘J’ for John’s.

In fact, you need to look under ‘Sa’. ‘St’ is short for Saint. The A-Z puts locations like this under ‘Sa’.

Likewise ‘Gt’ is short for ‘Great’ and is therefore listed under ‘Gre’.

## Objective 3: Finding ‘The’ locations

**Please find: The Crescent (*Droylsden*) (answer on page 21)**

Streets starting with ‘The’ are not listed under ‘The’.

For example, to find **The Crescent**, look under ‘Cre’ in the A-Z.

To help you, we have listed the alphabet below:

## **Section 1 - Part 3 – Private Hire Licence Conditions / Customer Care**

### **Objective: Learning the conditions of the licence and customer care**

There is a choice of 3 answers to each question and you must choose which answer is correct. You will need to get at least 8 of these correct to pass this section.

Some of the questions will ask about everyday situations a private hire driver might find him/herself in. You won't find the answer to these questions in the yellow booklet. You will need to use your judgement to decide which is the most appropriate answer to each question.

**1. What should you do if your customer asks you to allow 5 passengers in your private hire vehicle, when the maximum number permitted is 4 passengers?**

- A Take all 5 passengers but only if it's a short journey
- B Explain the vehicle is only licensed to carry 4 passengers and politely refuse
