4. Kerbs or Edgings are only permitted up to 3feet or 0.9m from the Headstone full length kerbs or edgings of any type are strictly forbidden and **WILL BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY AND WITHOUT NOTICE**
5. The popular belief that the land itself is purchased **is not correct**, as the purchaser acquires only the burial right to bury in that grave and the right to erect a memorial.
6. The land ownership and responsibility for its management remains with the Council.
