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Part 1 Introduction

1.1 Introduction

From 21 March 2011 Manchester City Council's Directorate for Adults is updating its purchasing arrangements for people it places in Care Homes within the City of Manchester. The Council also has a responsibility for the safety and wellbeing of all other residents in Care Homes, whether they have been placed there by other local authorities or are privately-funded. This contract and the revised monitoring arrangements that accompany it are designed to reflect this expanded role.

This contract has been written in anticipation of moving towards a joint care homes contract with our partners in NHS Manchester. It has been written as a mirror contract, reflecting the contract that is being designed by NHS Manchester.

1.2 What this document covers
