Information has been requested about where service users accepted into Manchester Foyer have come from in terms of locality and where they moved onto.

Table 1 below shows data for young people accepted into Manchester Foyer between September 2008 and September 2009. This demonstrates that people from different wards of Manchester access the service. There were 22 referrals accepted from people living outside Manchester. Of the 41 referrals accepted from people whose last residence was within Manchester boundaries, 6 people accepted into the service came from North Manchester wards, 4 people came from East Manchester wards, 20 people came from Central Manchester wards, 6 people came from South Manchester wards, 4 people came from Wythenshawe wards.

Table 2 shows the wards where young people who left the Foyer moved to. 38 out of 60 people stayed within Manchester and 19 people moved out of Manchester boundaries between September 2008 and September 2009.

Of the 19 people who moved from Manchester Foyer in a planned way to areas outside of Manchester boundaries, 13 moved to an area in a Greater Manchester authority and 6 moved to an authority outside of Greater Manchester.

Of the 38 people who moved out of the service but stayed within Manchester boundaries, 4 people moved into North Manchester wards, 5 people moved to East Manchester wards, 14 people moved to Central Manchester wards, 11 people moved to South Manchester wards, 4 people moved to Wythenshawe wards.

Out of the 60 people that moved out of the service in a planned way, 25 people moved back into their family home, 10 people moved into university accommodation and 9 people moved into their own tenancy. This shows that the service assisted in helping people return to their family home (therefore supporting service users to build up family relations), acquire their own tenancy (supporting them to manage their own tenancies) or find suitable university accommodation.
