

General terms & conditions for the erection of temporary signs

1. Terms and Conditions must be adhered to or The Highway Authority shall have the right, but not unreasonably so, to revoke the permit at any time.
2. The signs will conform with the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 ("the Regulations") and the applicant will comply with the same.
3. Should you breach the Regulations or otherwise fail to abide by the terms of any permission given, the Council may take action to remedy the breach, which may include your being liable to reimburse costs incurred by the Council and being prosecuted for committing a criminal offence.
4. You will be liable for all and any damage, injury or loss caused by or arising out of the presence of the signs or otherwise in connection with them and you will hold the Council immune from all such liability.
5. No more than one temporary directional sign may be erected on a street lighting column or other street furniture.
6. Permission to erect temporary signs on street lighting columns or any other street furniture does not convey a right to you to keep in place those signs that the Council reasonably require to be removed.
7. The signs must be erected to give a clear height of at least 2.44m (8'0") above the footway and at least 0.457m (1'6") from the kerb line. No signs may overhang any part of the carriageway.
8. The signs must be securely fixed to lighting columns by means of a non - rustable material or nylon webbing strap and not wire.
9. Signs on street lighting columns shall not exceed 0.6m². Where there are existing signs on columns no other signs will be permitted to be erected.
10. No temporary directional signs may be erected on any street lighting column or other street furniture on any part of the highway known as the Mancunian Way.
11. The only information that is to be put on the rear of the signs is your name, address, telephone number and the dates between which the signs may be erected. This information must be clearly visible from the highway. There must be no other advertising placed on the rear of the temporary signs.
12. The Maximum number of signs must correspond to the application initially made. Any additional signs must be paid for immediately.
13. The unique identifying licence number must be marked on the back of all the signs. Failure to display the correct number will result in the signs being removed and the licence being revoked.
14. The signs may be erected on and not prior to the date specified on the application.
15. The signs are to be removed on or before the date specified on the application.
