

Flagged Footways

HC/99/33 – POLICY ON REPAIRS AND RECONSTRUCTION OF FLAGGED FOOTWAYS

The Council policy when reconstructing footways is set out in HC/99/33, which was agreed with the Executive Member in June 2005.

The policy states that when footpaths constructed with paving flags are beyond economic repair and need planned maintenance, bituminous materials shall be used, except in Conservation Areas and High Amenity Areas - For these areas, the flagged footways should be reconstructed in similar flagged materials.

Minor repairs to flagged footways in reasonable condition are carried out in similar flagged materials, unless it is likely that defects will reoccur (eg. Tree root damage or vehicle overrun) in which case squared off bitmac repairs will be carried out.
