MANCHESTER CITY COUNCIL NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE A GATING ORDER SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Manchester City Council ("the Council") proposes for the purposes of reducing crime and antisocial behaviour to make an Order preventing anyone, other than those persons specified in the Order, from using the alleyways to the side of 1 Thorn Grove and to rear of 1 to 37 Thorn Grove and 72 to 76 Ladybarn Lane ("the Highways"). The Highways are shown edged in black and numbered 1, 2 and 3 on the attached plan. The restriction will apply at all times.

The Order will exempt any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the highways, any person engaged on Council business, emergency services personnel, statutory undertakers and utility providers from the restriction.

Alternative routes for pedestrians and vehicles are available by using the roads to the front of 1 to 37 Thorn Grove as shown by dotted lines on the attached plan. A draft of the proposed Order is set out in the Schedule to this Notice.

DRAFT GATING ORDER - SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 CITY OF MANCHESTER (THORN GROVE, WITHINGTON) GATING ORDER 2010

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyway to the side of 1 Thorn Grove and the alleyways to rear of 1 to 37 Thorn Grove and 72 to 76 Ladybarn Lane ("the Highways") shown edged black and numbered 1, 2 and 3 on the plan annexed to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, to any police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- 3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained at the entrance of the Highways adjoining 1 Thorn Grove and 37 Thorn Grove. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating the barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 234 4904.
- 4. The alternative routes for pedestrians and vehicular traffic which are available for use during the period the Highways are restricted are the roads to the front of 1 to 37 Thorn Grove as shown by dotted lines on the plan annexed to his Order.
