## Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (Amendment) (England) Order 2010

## Notice pursuant to Article 5(1) of the making of an Article 4 Direction

Manchester City Council made an Article 4 (1) Direction on 7<sup>th</sup> October 2010, under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) Order 1995, as amended. The Direction relates to development comprising change of use from a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) to a use falling within Class C4 (houses in multiple occupation) of that Order, and removes permitted development rights for this type of development from the date when the Direction comes into force. Planning permission will therefore be required for change of use from Class C3 to Class C4 once the Article 4 Direction is in force.

The Article 4 Direction applies to the whole of the Manchester City Council area. A copy of the Direction, including a map defining the area covered, can be viewed at the City Council's Customer Service Centre, Ground Floor, One First Street, Manchester; or can be viewed on the Council's website at www.manchester.gov.uk/info/500207/planning\_and\_buildings

Representations may be made concerning the Article 4 Direction between 8<sup>th</sup> October and 29<sup>th</sup> October 2010. The Article 4 Direction, will come into force, subject to confirmation by the City Council, on 8<sup>th</sup> October 2011.
