

SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
CITY OF MANCHESTER (ALLEYWAYS IN THE THORNTON ROAD AREA,
MOSS SIDE) GATING ORDER 2010

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public rights of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in Schedule 1 to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply:
 - a) to any occupier of the premises specified in Column 1 of Schedule 3 to this Order adjoining or adjacent to the Highways as specified in Column 2 of Schedule 3 to this Order ; and
 - b) to any person engaged on Council business, police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained to the side of 16 Dalton Avenue, to the rear of 2 Dalton Avenue, to the side of 160 / 162 Thornton Road, to the side of 140 / 142 Thornton Road, to the side of 120 / 122 Thornton Road, to the rear of 120 Thornton Road, to the rear 122 Thornton Road, to the side of 100 / 102 Thornton Road, to the rear of 82 Thornton Road, to the rear of 80 Thornton Road, to the side of 60 / 62 Thornton Road, to the rear of 42 Thornton Road, to the rear of 40 Thornton Road, to the side of 20 / 22 Thornton Road and to the side of 2 Thornton Road. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 234 4904.
4. An alternative route for vehicles and pedestrians is available by using the existing highways of Thornton Road and Dalton Avenue as shown by dotted lines on the Order plan.
5. This Order shall take effect on 13 October 2010.

SCHEDULE 1

Highways to be restricted

- 1) The alleyway situated to the side of 16 Dalton Avenue continuing to the rear of 4 – 16 Dalton Avenue over its full length of 39 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '1' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 2) The alleyway running from the rear boundary of 2 Thornton Road upto the rear western boundary of 40 Thornton Road for its full length of 91 metres and for its full width excluding the area of private land described in Part 1 of Schedule 2 below. Shown marked '2A' and edged in black on the Order plan.

- 3) The alleyway running from the rear eastern boundary of 42 Thornton Road upto the rear western boundary of 80 Thornton Road for its full length of 86 metres and for its full width excluding the areas of private land described in Part 2 of Schedule 2 below. Shown marked '2B' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 4) The alleyway running from the rear eastern boundary of 82 Thornton Road upto the rear boundary of 120 Thornton Road for its full length of 85 metres and for its full width excluding the areas of private land described in Part 3 of Schedule 2 below. Shown marked '2C' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 5) The alleyway running from the rear boundary of 120 Thornton Road upto the rear of 176 Thornton Road and continuing to the side of 2 to 4 Dalton Avenue for its full length of 128 metres excluding the areas of private land described in Part 4 of Schedule 2 below. Shown marked '2D' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 6) The alleyway situated to the side of 160 – 162 Thornton Road over its full length of 17 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '3' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 7) The alleyway situated to the side of 140 – 142 Thornton Road over its full length of 17 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '4' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 8) The alleyway situated to the side of 120 - 122 Thornton Road over its full length of 17 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '5' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 9) The alleyway situated to the side of 100 – 102 Thornton Road over its full length of 17 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '6' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 10) The alleyway situated to the side of 60 – 62 Thornton Road over its full length of 17 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '8' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 11) The alleyway situated to the side of 20 – 22 Thornton Road over its full length of 17 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '10' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 12) The alleyway situated to the rear of 30 –36 Yew Tree Road over its full length of 20 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '11' and edged in black on the Order plan.

SCHEDULE 2

Areas of private land

Part 1

The area of private land to the rear of 8 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the south western end of the rear of 8 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 1 metre and with a width of 2.9 metres. Shown coloured black and marked as 'H' on the plan.

Part 2

The areas of private land

- a) to the rear of 56 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the rear boundary of 56 to 58 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 3 metres and with a width of 2.9 metres. Shown coloured black and marked as 'G' on the plan.

b) to the rear of 72 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the rear boundary of 72 to 74 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 3 metres and with a width of 2.9 metres. Shown coloured black and marked as 'F' on the plan.

Part 3

The areas of private land

- a) to the rear of 90 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the rear boundary of 90 to 92 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 3 metres and with a width of 2.8 metres. Shown coloured black and marked 'E' on the plan
 b) to the rear of 116 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the rear boundary of 116 to 118 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 1 metre and with a width of 2.8 metres. Shown coloured black and marked 'D' on the plan

Part 4

The areas of private land

- a) to the rear of 132 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the rear boundary of 134 to 132 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 1 metre and with a width of 2.8 metres. Shown coloured black and marked 'C' on the plan
 b) to the rear of 152 Thornton Road running from 2 metres north east of the rear boundary of 152 and 154 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 1 metre and with a width of 2.8 metres. Shown coloured black and marked 'B' on the plan.
 c) to the rear of 162 Thornton Road running from the rear boundary of 162 to 164 Thornton Road in a north easterly direction for 3 metres and with a width of 2.8 metres. Shown coloured black and marked 'A' on the plan.
