NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE A GATING ORDER

SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

BROOM LANE/FERNLEIGH AVENUE AREA ALLEYWAYS, CHORLTON

Manchester City Council ("the Council") proposes for the purposes of reducing crime and antisocial behaviour to make an Order preventing anyone, other than those persons specified in the Order, from using the alleyways described in Schedule 1 to this Notice ("the Highways"). The Highways are shown as 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 on the plan attached to the Order ("the Order Plan"). The restriction will apply at all times.

The Order will exempt any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways, any person engaged on Council business, emergency services personnel, statutory undertakers and utility providers from the restriction.

Alternative routes for pedestrians and vehicles are available by using Dorset Road, Broom Lane, Thorncliffe Grove and Fernleigh Avenue as shown by dotted lines on the Order Plan. A draft of the proposed Order is set out in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

A copy of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order, a plan and other associated papers are available for inspection at Room 601, City Solicitor's Office, Town Hall, Manchester, M60 2LA during normal office hours. Alleyways to be gated

Alleyway situated to the side of 198/200 Broom Lane for the full length of 25 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '1' on the Order Plan;

Alleyway situated to the rear of 178-220 Broom Lane and the rear of 1-43 Fernleigh Avenue continuing to the side of 1 Thorncliffe Grove for the full length of 115 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '2' on the Order Plan;

Alleyway situated to the side of 21/23 Fernleigh Avenue for the full length of 22 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '3' on the Order Plan;

Alleyway situated to the rear of 2a-6 Dorset Road of 18 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '4' on the Order Plan;

Alleyway situated to the side of 222-230 Broom Lane for the full length of 24 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '5' on the Order Plan;

SCHEDULE 2

DRAFT GATING ORDER - SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 **CITY OF MANCHESTER (BROOM LANE/ FERNLEIGH AVENUE) GATING** **ORDER 2011**

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order ("the Plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, to police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained at the following locations: set back so as to be level with the front corner of the gable end at 198 Broom Lane, 21 Fernleigh Avenue and 43 Fernleigh Avenue, at each end of the Highway marked '2' on the Plan. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 234 4904.
4. The alternative routes for pedestrians and vehicles which are available for use during the period the Highways are restricted are Dorset Road, Broom Lane, Thorncliffe Grove and Fernleigh Avenue as shown by dotted lines on the Plan.
5. This Order shall take effect on the day of 2011.

Alleyway situated to the rear of 2a-6 Dorset Road of 18 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '4' on the Plan;

Alleyway situated to the side of 222-230 Broom Lane for the full length of 24 metres, and for the full width, shown marked '5' on the Plan;
