

SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
CITY OF MANCHESTER (LYTHAM AVENUE / CLEVELEYS AVENUE AREA,
CHORLTON) GATING ORDER 2010

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, to police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the Highway shown marked '1' and at the southern end of the Highway shown marked '2' on the plan. Neighbourhood Services, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating the barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 245 7850.
4. The alternative routes for pedestrians which are available for use during the period the Highways are restricted are available by using Lytham Avenue, St Anne's Road, Clevelleys Avenue and the alley situated to the sides of 22 Clevelleys Avenue and 11 Lytham Avenue, as shown by dotted lines on the attached plan.
5. This Order shall take effect on the 6th day of December 2010.

SCHEDULE

Alleyways to be gated

Alleyway located to the rear of 38-48 St Anne's Road for the full length of approximately 29 metres and for the full width, shown marked '1' on the plan.

Alleyway located to the rear of 1-11 Lytham Avenue / 12-22 Clevelleys Avenue for the full length of approximately 35 metres and for the full width, shown marked '2' on the plan.
