NOTICE OF MAKING OF A GATING ORDER
SECTION 129A - F HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
CITY OF MANCHESTER (ALLEYWAYS IN THE TOXTETH STREET AREA,
BRADFORD) GATING ORDER 2010

Notice is hereby given that Manchester City Council ("the Council") has on 20th December 2010 made an Order under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") for the purposes of reducing crime and antisocial behaviour. The effect of the Order is to prevent anyone, other than those persons specified in the Order, from using the alleyways listed in Schedule 1 to this Notice ("the Highways"). The Highways are shown as '1' and '2' on the Order plan. The restriction will apply at all times. A copy of the Order is set out in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

The Order comes into effect on 4th January 2011. A copy of the Order together with a plan may be inspected at Room 601, Town Hall, Manchester, M60 2LA and in the register of gating orders which is located in the Private Sector Housing, Universal Square, Devonshire Street North Manchester. Both offices are open between the hours 9.00am and 4.30pm on Monday to Friday. A copy of Order and plan can be viewed by visiting the Council's website www.manchester.gov.uk under Housing/Private Housing/Homeowners/Alley and Alleygating.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the Order or any provision contained in it on the ground that the Council has no power to make it or that any requirement under Part 8A of the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks beginning with the date on which the Order was made apply to the High Court for such purpose.

Alleyways to be gated

- 1) The alleyway situated to the side of 110 Toxteth Street for its full length of 18 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '1' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 2) The alleyway situated to the rear of 110 – 118 Toxteth Street over its full length of 29 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '2' and edged in black on the Order plan.

SCHEDULE 2
SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
CITY OF MANCHESTER (ALLEYWAYS IN THE TOXTETH STREET AREA,
BRADFORD) GATING ORDER 2010

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained at the ends of the Highways. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 245 7850.
4. Alternative routes for vehicles and pedestrians which are available for use during the period the Highways are restricted are the existing highways of Toxteth Street and Club Street and pedestrians may continue along the footpath to the rear of 118 Toxteth Street as shown by dotted lines on the Order plan.
5. This Order shall take effect on the 4th day of January 2011.

- 1) The alleyway situated to the side of 110 Toxteth Street for its full length of 18 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '1' and edged in black on the Order plan.
- 2) The alleyway situated to the rear of 110 – 118 Toxteth Street over its full length of 29 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '2' and edged in black on the Order plan.
