

**SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**  
**CITY OF MANCHESTER (MELLER ROAD AREA, LONGSIGHT) GATING**  
**ORDER 2011**

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, to police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
3. Barriers may be installed, operated and maintained on the Highways at their junctions with Mentor Street and Meller Road. Neighbourhood Services, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 245 7805.
4. The alternative routes for pedestrians which are available for use during the period the Highways are restricted are Meller Road, Hamilton Road, Mentor Street and Slade Lane as shown by dotted lines on the attached plan.
5. This Order shall take effect on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 2011.

**SCHEDULE**  
**Alleyways to be gated**

Alleyway situated to the rear of 163-167 Hamilton Road for the full length of 15 metres and for the full width, shown marked '1' on the plan.

Alleyway situated to the rear of 2-30 Meller Road/5-29 Mentor Street for the full length of 70 metres and for the full width, shown marked '2' on the plan.

Alleyway situated to the side of 19/21 Mentor Street for the full length of 18 metres and for the full width, shown marked '3' on the plan.

Alleyway situated to the side of 68/76 Slade Lane / 2 Meller Street and to the rear of 3 Mentor Street for the full length of 16 metres and for the full width, shown marked '4' on the plan.
