SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 CITY OF MANCHESTER (BROOK GREEN LANE, GORTON SOUTH) GATING ORDER 2011

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyway ("the Highway") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 of this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highway or to any person engaged on Council business, to police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highway.
- 3. A barrier will be installed, operated and maintained at the junction of the Highway adjacent to the rear of 39 Laburnum Road. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating the barrier. Their contact telephone number is 0161 234 4904. Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council will be responsible for gating the continuation of the route (shaded blue on the Plan).
- 4. The alternative routes for pedestrians which are available for use during the period the Highway is restricted are Mayfield Grove, Laburnum Road and Reddish Lane as shown by dotted lines on the plan annexed to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on the 3rd day of February 2011.

SCHEDULE

Alleyway to be gated

That part of the alleyway known as Brook Green Lane (footpath 137) within the Manchester City boundary which runs between the rear of 39 Laburnum Road and the rear of 56-58 Mayfield Grove for its full length of 40 metres, and for its full width, shown marked '1' on the Plan.
