## **SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

## CITY OF MANCHESTER (ALLEYWAYS IN THE HORTON ROAD AREA, MOSS SIDE) GATING ORDER 2011

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- 3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained at the sides of 137 and 139 Thornton Road, 117 and 119 Thornton Road, 97 and 99 Thornton Road, 134 and 136 Horton Road, 114 and 116 Horton Road, 94 and 96 Horton Road and to the rear of 76. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 234 4904.
- 4. The alternative route which is available for use by pedestrians during the period the Highways are restricted are the existing footways of Horton Road, Thornton Road, Rosedale Road and the alleyway between 74 and 76 Horton Road and 77 and 79 Thornton Road as shown by dotted lines on the plan annexed to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on the 14 April 2011.

## **SCHEDULE**

## Alleyways to be gated

Alleyway to the rear of 76 to 134 Horton Road with a length of 127 metres for its full width shown marked '1' on the plan.

Alleyway between 137 and 139 Thornton Road and continuing to 134 and 136 Horton Road with a length of 35 metres for its full width shown marked '2' on the plan.

Alleyway between 117 and 119 Thornton Road with a length of 17 metres for its full width shown marked '3' on the plan.

Alleyway between 114 and 116 Horton Road with a length of 17 metres for its full width shown marked '4' on the plan.

Alleyway between 97 and 99 Thornton Road with a length of 17 metres for its full width shown marked '5' on the plan.

Alleyway between 94 and 96 Horton Road with a length of 17 metres for its full width shown marked '6' on the plan.
