CITY OF MANCHESTER (ALLEYWAYS IN THE NORBRECK AVENUE AREA, CHORLTON) GATING ORDER 2011

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- 3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained to the rear of 20 and 36 St Annes Road and to the rear of 15 Norbreck Avenue / 22 Lytham Avenue. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 245 7850.
- 4. An alternative route for pedestrians which is available for use during the period the Highways are restricted are the existing highways of Norbreck Avenue, St Annes Road and Lytham Avenue and the alley situated to the side of 15 Norbreck Avenue continuing to the side of 22 Lytham Avenue as shown by dotted lines on the Order plan.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on the 11 November 2011.

SCHEDULE

Alleyways to be gated

The alleyway situated to the rear of 20 - 36 St Annes Road over a length of 36 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '1' and edged in black on the Order plan.

The alleyway situated to the rear of 1 - 15 Norbreck Avenue and the rear of 8 - 22 Lytham Avenue over its full length of 37 metres and for its full width. Shown marked '2' and edged in black on the Order plan.
