

SCHEDULE 2
DRAFT GATING ORDER - CITY OF MANCHESTER (CHIPPENHAM ROAD
AREA, MILES PLATTING) GATING ORDER 2012

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the Order plan and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained adjacent to the rear boundary of 2 Tidworth Avenue and to the side of the 'Manchester Christian College' building from the Chippenham Road end. Private Sector Housing, Neighbourhood Services, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 245 7850.
4. The alternative route which is available for use by pedestrians during the period the Highways are restricted are the existing footways of Old Mill Street and Chippenham Road as shown by dotted lines on the Order plan.
5. This Order shall take effect on the date hereof.

Alleyways to be gated

Alleyway situated 5.5 metres from the back of the footway to the south westerly side of the 'Manchester Christian College' building from the Old Mill Street end for a length of 22 metres and width of 3 metres shown as marked '1' on the plan.

Alleyway situated 11 metres from the back of the footway to the north westerly side of the 'Manchester Christian College' building from the Chippenham Road end for a length of 26 metres and with a width varying between 2.7 metres and 3.3 metres shown as marked '2' on the plan.

Manchester City Council ("the Council") proposes for the purposes of reducing crime and antisocial behaviour to make an Order preventing anyone, other than those persons specified in the Order, from using the alleyways described in Schedule 1 to this Notice ("the Highways"). The Highways are shown as '1' and '2' on the Order plan. The restrictions will apply at all times.


The Order will exempt any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways, any person engaged on Council business, emergency services personnel, statutory undertakers and utility providers from the restriction.

Alternative routes for pedestrians are available by using the existing footways of Old Mill Street and Chippenham Road as shown by dotted lines on the Order plan. A draft of the proposed Order is set out in Schedule 2 to this Notice.

A copy of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order, a plan and other associated papers are available for inspection at Room 601, City Solicitor's Office, Town Hall, Manchester, M60 2LA during normal office hours.
