## **SECTION 129A HIGHWAYS ACT 1980**

## CITY OF MANCHESTER (LINCOLN STREET/ ST JOHN'S ROAD AREA, LONGSIGHT) GATING ORDER 2012

The Council of the City of Manchester in exercise of its power under Section 129A (1) of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act have been met hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. Except as provided in Article 2 to this Order no person shall use the public right of way over the alleyways ("the Highways") shown edged black on the plan annexed to this Order and described in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 2. The restriction in Article 1 to this Order shall not apply to any occupier of premises adjoining or adjacent to the Highways or to any person engaged on Council business, police, ambulance or fire service personnel acting in pursuance of statutory powers or duties or to any statutory undertaker, gas, electricity, water or communications provider requiring access to their apparatus situated in the Highways.
- 3. Barriers will be installed, operated and maintained at each end of the highway to the rear 1-17 Holmfirth Street and to the side of 2 Lincoln Street. Private Sector Housing, Central Operations Division is responsible for maintaining and operating any barriers. Their contact telephone number is 0161 245 7850.
- 4. The alternative route which is available for use by pedestrians during the period the Highways are restricted are the existing footways of Lincoln Street, Holmfirth Street, St John's Road and Dickenson Road as shown by dotted lines on the plan annexed to this Order.
- 5. This Order shall take effect on the 8 May 2012

## SCHEDULE Alleyways to be gated

Alleyway located to the rear of 1-17 Holmfirth Street for a length of 41 metres and for its full width as shown marked '1' on the plan.

Alleyway located to the rear of 2-18 Lincoln Street for a length of 44 metres and with a width varying between 2.7 metres and 5 metres as shown marked '2' on the plan.

Alleyway situated to the side of 2 Lincoln Street and 357/359 Dickenson Road for a length of 22 metres and with a width varying between 2.5 metres and 3.3 metres as shown marked '3' on the plan.
