## Section 1 - Guidance Notes

Public Health Law requires that hairdressers and barbers operate hygienically. The hygiene standards required are listed in the bye-laws made under the local Government Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1982. These standards are enforced by officers from Regulatory & Enforcement Services.

Hairdressers and barbers are required to register premises with Manchester City Council when opening new premises and when a new occupier takes over an existing salon. In the case of mobile hairdressers, the premises would be the home address of that hairdresser / barber.

## Once registered, is that it?

Once registered, is that it? No. You have only informed the council who / where you are.

After registration you will be inspected by an Officer from Regulatory & Enforcement Services.

The inspection will be combined with a Health and Safety inspection under the Health and Safety at Work, etc., Act 1974.
