You cannot make application for a new zoo licence until you have submitted a 'Notice of intention to apply for a zoo licence', please see Zoo Licence notification.

Your application for a zoo licence can only be made at least two months after the date of your notice of intention.

Your application will need to include the conservation measures that are to be applied at the zoo.
