Air Quality Management Area Order

The Greater Manchester Combined Authority, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 83(2) of the Environment Act 1995 and the Greater Manchester Combined Authority Order 2011, hereby makes the following order.

This order may be cited as the Greater Manchester Combined Authority Air Quality Management Area Order 2016 and shall come into effect on 1 May 2016.

The areas highlighted on the attached map numbered Map 1 show the areas set out in the following orders:

- 1. The Bolton Borough Council Air Quality Management Area Designation Order 2002
- 2. The Metropolitan Borough of Bury Air Quality Management Order 2002 (Amendment) Order 2007 dated 15th February 2007
- 3. City of Manchester Air Quality Management Area Variation Order 2007 dated 6th November 2007
- 4. The Metropolitan Borough of Oldham Air Quality Management Area Designation Order 2001 dated 1st June 2001
- 5. Rochdale Borough Council (Designation of Air Quality Management Areas) Order 2002 (Variation) Order 2005, dated 3 November 2005
- 6. City of Salford Air Quality Management Order dated 1st August 2005
- 7. The Metropolitan Borough Council of Stockport Air Quality Management Area Designation Order 2005 dated 28th July 2005
- 8. The Metropolitan Borough of Tameside Air Quality Management Area Designation Order 2005 dated 31st August 2005
- 9. Amendment to the Trafford Metropolitan Borough Council Air Quality Management Area Designation Order 2001
- 10. The Wigan Borough Council Air Quality Management Area (Variation)
 Order 2005 dated 21st October 2005

The areas shown coloured blue on the attached map numbered Map 1 are to be superseded by the areas shown coloured red on the second attached map numbered Map 2 and referred to as the Greater Manchester Combined Authority Air Quality Management Area Order 2016. The designation areas are all contained within the area of the Greater Manchester Combined Authority.

The areas shown on the attached map numbered Map 2 are designated in relation to a likely breach of a nitrogen dioxide (annual mean) objective of 35 micrograms per cubic metre, a more stringent objective than the annual mean

objective of 40 micrograms per cubic metre specified in the Air Quality (England) Regulations 2000 (as amended).

This order shall remain in force until it is varied or revoked by a subsequent order of the Greater Manchester Combined Authority.


