

DIRECTORY OF NATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH PROFILES AND ONLINE DATA TOOLS FOR LOCAL AREAS

Public Health England (PHE) provides many high quality data and analysis tools and resources for public health professionals. Taken as a whole, these provide a wealth of high quality, comparative information about the health of the population. The number and variety of profiles that are available can make it difficult for current or potential users to find the information they need. The purpose of this brief summary is to bring together background information about all the available profiles within a single document that users can refer to when they are trying to access information on a particular topic.

The following table lists all of the currently available health profiles in alphabetical order and contains information on the provider, date of last update, geographical coverage and a brief summary of the contents of each profile. A direct link to each profile is given in the final column for any users wishing to access the full content and functionality of each of the websites.

The majority of the profiles listed use the PHE Fingertips Health Profiles tool as a way of accessing the data (see <https://fingertips.phe.org.uk/>). This tool allows users to browse indicators at different geographical levels, benchmark against the regional or England average and export data to use locally.
