What is the decision?	To increase the charge for Housing Demand Notices to £300
Reasons for the decision (but excluding any exempt or confidential information)	Currently the charge for housing demand notices is based on an hourly rate of £46 per hour that does not reflect the actual costs incurred. Many authorities charge a flat rate for housing demand notices as it is administratively more efficient and removes inconsistencies that can arise when hourly rates are applied. The proposal is to introduce a flat rate at a charge of £300 to achieve closer to cost recovery
