What is the decision?	To set the level for Fixed Penalty Notices for household waste duty of care offences at the maximum level of £400, reduced to £250 if paid within 10 days
Reasons for the decision (but excluding any exempt or confidential information)	On 22 November 2018, the Secretary of State made the Environmental Protection (Miscellaneous Amendments) (England and Wales) Regulations 2018. These regulations inserted s34.ZA into the Environmental Protection Act 1990, which allows local authorities to issue Fixed Penalty Notices for alleged household waste duty of care offences. Under the legislation, such Fixed Penalty Notices can be set at any amount between £150 and £400. If no amount is set, the 'default' amount will be set at £200. Prior to this there was no provision to issue an FPN for household waste duty of care offences. The regulations came into effect on 7 January 2019.
