In November 2013 Northenden Neighbourhood Forum was designated by MCC as the Neighbourhood Forum for the Northenden Neighbourhood Area for an initial 5 year period.

We seek please to renew this application for a further term. NNF has been an active community organisation during the whole of the period of existence. We have held regular monthly General meetings, monthly Executive Committee meetings and discussed a range of topics including a number of Planning matters with invited speakers / developers.

We have made representations on a number of subjects and facilitated discussion and mutual understanding between various residents, groups, businesses, public and voluntary bodies in the area.

We have worked on developing a Neighbourhood Plan which MCC Planning Strategy have offered comments on last year, and for which we intend to apply for further funding to take to the next consultation stage, including inclusion of Design Codes to inform future development in the Forum's area.

In addition to the meetings mentioned above we have communicated with members and others by email & Twitter, arranged a number of stalls in the Village at different events and maintained a thriving Facebook Page (Northenden Neighbourhood Forum) with a reach of several thousand people.

Our membership is open to all who qualify and is free of charge. It currently stands at 540 and is drawn from residents of, people who work in and own businesses in, & elected representatives for Northenden. A number of other voluntary groups are represented amongst our membership, and our residential members' addresses cover all parts of the designated area. The three local Councillors are NNF members.

We have undertaken several other projects in our own right including Northenden Hive and crowdfunding for the provision of Christmas Lights, and we have supported and liaised with numerous other groups and public bodies.

Our Constitution is largely unaltered from that approved by MCC in the previous designation. The one change is in the last paragraph of Section 6 where we have made more explicit the requirement for the level of notice that must be provided for Committee meetings and increased the number of meetings that the Committee are expected to arrange. The revised paragraph is shown in red on the attached Constitution for your ease of reference.

The Council will check that the application meets the requirements above. In making a decision about whether to designate the neighbourhood forum, the Council must also consider the extent to which the body applying to be a neighbourhood forum has:-

- Secured, or taken reasonable steps to secure, membership from at least one individual falling within the categories in (b) above.
- Drawn its membership from different places within the neighbourhood area concerned, and from different sections of the community in the area.
- A purpose which reflects the character of the neighbourhood area (in general terms).

The Council will use the address, age, ethnicity and occupation information provided under Question 3 to assess the extent to which membership is drawn from different places and different sections of the community. However community groups may wish to set out in their statement how they have addressed the first and third bullet points above.
