Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended)

Direction made under Article 4(1)

Relating to a change of use from

Retail; Food and Drink; and Financial, Professional and Other Services to Dwellinghouses in parts of the City Centre, Manchester

Whereas the Council of the City of Manchester being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4(5) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended), are satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the First Schedule below should not be carried out on the land described in the Second Schedule below and shown edged red on the attached plan, unless planning permission is granted on an application made under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended).

Now therefore the said Council in pursuance of the power conferred on them by Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to the development specified in the First Schedule below in respect of the land specified in the Second Schedule below and shown edged red on the attached plan:

First Schedule

Description of development

Development consisting of a change of use of a building and any land within its curtilage from a use falling within Class E (a, b, and c) (retail; food and drink; and financial,

professional and other services) of Schedule 2 to the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended), to a use falling within Class C3 (dwellinghouses) of Schedule 1 to that Order being development comprised within **Class MA of Part 3 of Schedule 2** to the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended) and not being development comprised within any other Class.

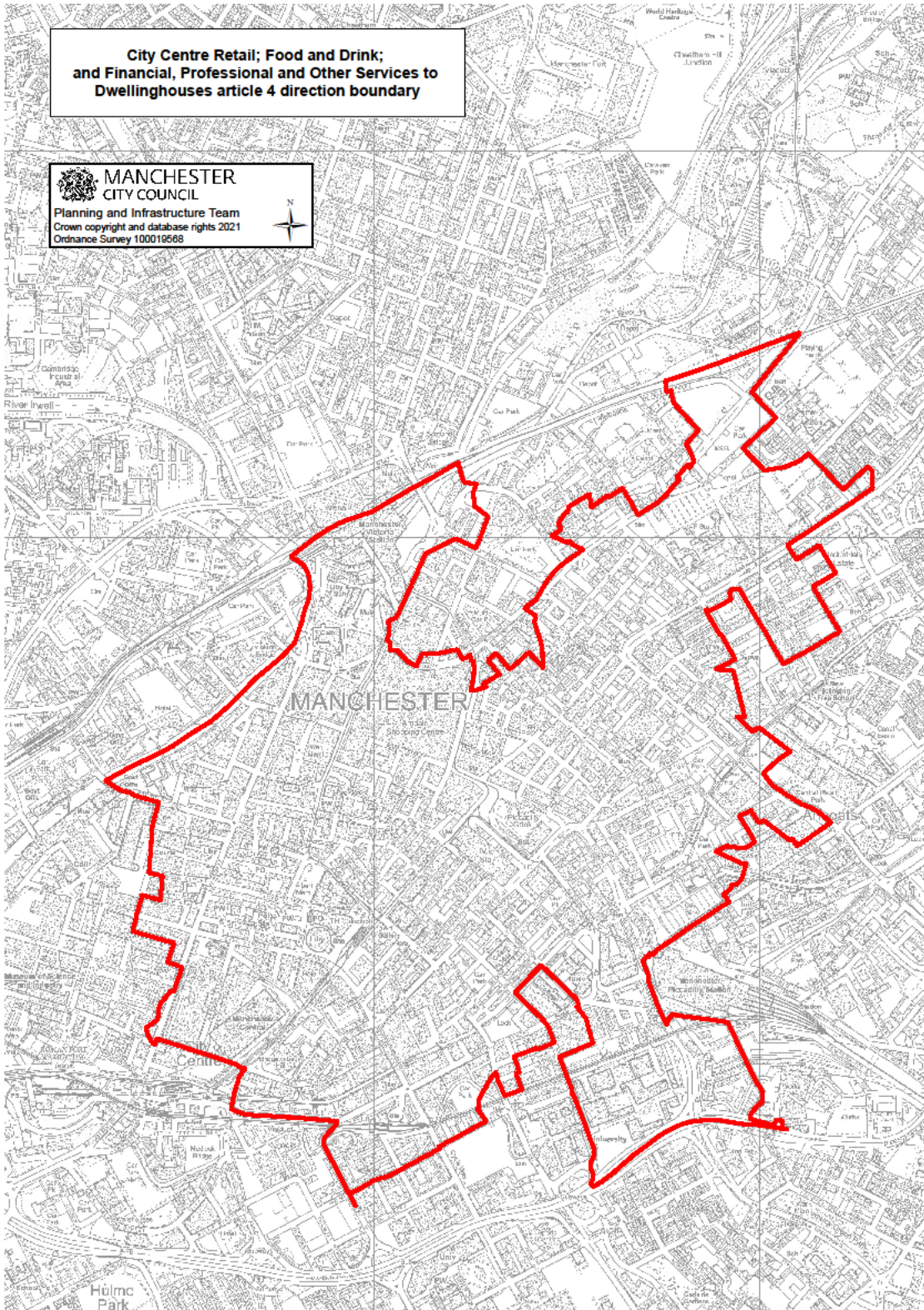
Those parts of the City Centre comprising:

3. The Northern Quarter;
