Providing for Housing Choice Draft Supplementary Planning Document and Planning Guidance: Notice of public consultation pursuant to Regulation 17 Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004

Manchester City Council has prepared a draft Supplementary Planning Document and Planning Guidance entitled Providing for Housing Choice. This document relates to the whole of Manchester District and sets out policies to widen the housing mix in Manchester in order to enhance regeneration by creating greater choice, diversity and affordability in the housing stock.
